

Tric a Chlic words

Dyma rhestr o eiriau tri swm-geiriau cytsain, llafariad, cytsain (c,ll,c).

A allwch chi helpu eich plentyn trwy wneud y gweithgareddau canlynol gydag ef/hi yn aml:

- Darllenwch y geiriau fel cardiau fflach- m-a-m (ynganu'r llythrennau yn unigol yn gyntaf ac wedyn dweud y gair- 'mam'.)
- Sillafu'r geiriau gan ysgrifennu- cymysgu'r llythrennau-' a, a, m' ac ail drefnu'r llythrennau i sillafu'r gair- 'mam'.
- Ynganu'r gair- 'mam' a gofyn 'Beth yw'r tri llythyren?'
Plentyn yn ynganu- m, a, m.
- Ynganu'r tri llythyren yn unigol-' m, a, m' a gofyn i'r plentyn 'Beth yw'r gair?'- plentyn yn ynganu 'mam'.
- Torri'r geiriau i fynu ac ail drefnu i greu'r gair eto.

Here is a list of three letter words- consonant, vowel, consonant words (c,v,c). Please could you help your child by doing the following activities with him/her regularly:

- Read the words as flash cards- m-a-m (say the letters individually first and then say the word- 'mam'.)
- Spell the words by writing them out- mix up the letters-'a, a, m' and then re-arrange to spell the word-'mam'.
- Say the word- 'mam' and ask 'What are the three letter sounds?'
Child says- m, a, m.
- Say the three letter sounds individually- 'm, a, m' and ask 'What is the word?'- Child says- 'mam'.
- 'Cut-up' the words and re-arrange to 'make' the word again.




Tric a Chlic cam/stage 2 a 3



A-a	Short sound as in the end or long sound as in calf
B-b	As in bat
C-c	As in cat. It never has the s sound.
Ch-ch	As in Scottish loch
D-d	As in dog
Dd-dd	As in the
E-e	Short sound as in egg or long sound as in made
F- f	As in vine
Ff-ff	As in from
G-g	As in goat. It never has soft g sounds as in George.
Ng-ng	As in singing
H-h	As in here. It is never silent as in hour.
I-i	Short sounds as in ink or long as in feed.
J-j	As in jam

L-l	As in loose`
LI- ll	No equivalent sounds in English, listen to child saying Llangrannog
M-m	As in mouse
N-n	As in now
O-o	Short sound as in not or long sound as in sore.
P-p	As in paper
Ph-ph	As in phone
R-r	Well trilled as in horrid
Rh-rh	Not heard in English- compare with perhaps (especially Scottish pronunciation)
S- s	As in sound
T-t	As in tongue
Th-th	As in thing
U-u	Short sounds as in ink
W-w	Long sounds as in cool
Y- y	Obscure sound, Long sounds as in mean
